



eHealth Saskatchewan Requirements for New Pharmacies

The Ministry of Health requires that all new pharmacies must integrate with the Pharmaceutical Information Program (PIP) as of their opening date.

Read and Sign the PIP Joint Service Access and Policy (JSAP): Prior to a new store opening, the Pharmacy Manager must read and accept the terms of the PIP Joint Service Access and Policy (JSAP). The steps to follow are provided below:

1. Read the PIP JSAP on the Pharmaceutical Information Program (PIP) website (<https://pip.ehealthsask.ca/>)
2. Print and sign the PIP JSAP Confirmation of Receipt and Acceptance on the eHealth Saskatchewan (eHS) website (<https://www.ehealthsask.ca/services/pip/Pages/Register-PIP-Account.aspx>)

Note: Only **written** signatures are accepted and the organization specified must be the same name as entered on the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacy Professionals online Proprietary Pharmacy Permit Application form.

3. E-mail or fax the signed PIP JSAP form to the eHS Service Desk (Email: servicedesk@ehealthsask.ca; Fax: 306-781-8480)
4. Complete the PIP Training for Approvers and Trustees on the eHealth website. (<https://www.ehealthsask.ca/services/pip/Pages/PIP-Training-Resources.aspx>)
