**Re: Additional COVID-19 Immunizations Discontinued for Travel Purposes**

Dear Colleagues:

Effective immediately:

1. Additional COVID-19 vaccine doses for travel purposes will no longer be provided to those 18 years and older, as this population is eligible to receive a booster dose three months after the last dose of their COVID-19 primary immunization series.
2. The *COVID-19 Vaccine Benefit/Risk Form for Individuals Requesting to Receive Additional (Third and/or Fourth) Doses* is no longer required to be completed and the August 17, 2021, directive letter to use this form, especially for travellers, has been rescinded.
